

V Seven International Congress of Health

Art. 1º. Seven Publicações Ltda., headquartered in the city of São José dos Pinhais, located at the address: Travessa Ferdinando Aristides Moleta CEP: 83045-090, registered with the CNPJ under number 43.789.355/001-14, in partnership with Uniasselvi University Center (Itupeva Polo).

Seven Publicações Ltda., through its organizer Nathan Albano Valente, informs that registrations for the V Seven International Congress of Health are open as of January 8, 2025, which will take place on April 8, 2025. The rules for participation are defined by this notice.

§1º. The V Seven International Congress of Health aims to promote and encourage academic production and critical analysis of topics related to the health field. In addition, it seeks to disseminate best practices and quality works, fostering scientific discussion and providing opportunities for interaction between the academic community and the business and governmental sectors related to health.

§ 2º. This event will be valid throughout the national and international territory, and participation is open to undergraduate students, professors, researchers, academic community, businesspeople, consultants, professionals, and others interested in health-related topics.

§3º. The evaluation committee of the V Seven International Congress of Health will be composed of professionals from the field(s), appointed at the discretion of the event's organizing committee.

§4º. Evaluators, members of the evaluation committee, cannot have any direct family relation (up to the second degree, by blood, adoption, or affinity) with the authors they are evaluating, ensuring impartiality in the decisions.

THE PARTICIPANTS

Art. 2º. Participation in the congress is open to students enrolled in any level of undergraduate, graduate, master's, or doctoral programs, as well as those who have completed their courses from the first year or semester of any course at an institution, provided they are regularly enrolled or have graduated and register for the V Seven International Congress of Health.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

Art. 3º. Submission must be done by at least one (1) of the authors to submit the work, listing the names of the other authors who contributed to the article. Co-authorship of up to 10 (ten) participants is allowed, provided all members meet the requirements of Art. 2º of this notice.

§1º. The theme will be freely chosen by the participants, as long as it is based on the following areas:

- Medicine;
- Dentistry;

- Pharmacy;
- Nursing;
- Nutrition;
- Public Health;
- Speech Therapy;
- Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy;
- Physical Education.

§2º. Articles that do not reference research results or do not indicate the data of the research(s) they are based on will be disqualified, as well as articles submitted after the deadline established in this notice.

§3º. Articles with authorship issues or any other illegality will be disqualified.

SUBMISSION

Art. 3º. Articles must be submitted by 11:59 PM on April 7, 2025.

Art. 4º. All work submissions are free of charge, as they will first be submitted for evaluation, with the formal acceptance letter sent only after approval to begin the payment process.

§ 1º. Corrections will be made on an ongoing basis, as well as submissions. After review, we will contact the participant via email at congresso@sevenevents.com.br or sevenpublicacoes@hotmail.com.

§ 2º To participate as an attendee, simply fill out the form on the website, and we will confirm the registration via email.

§ 3º For participation as an attendee, the registration fee is R\$ 30.00 (Thirty Reais).

§ 4º For participation with submission of works and possible presentation, the participation fee will be R\$ 167.00 (One hundred sixty-seven Reais) per work that receives formal acceptance via email.

RULES FOR SUBMISSION

Art. 5º. The full article must contain a minimum of 8 (eight) and a maximum of 35 (thirty-five) pages. The clinical study must contain a minimum of 4 (four) and a maximum of 20 (twenty) pages. The extended abstract must contain a minimum of 1 (one) and a maximum of 4 (four) pages. The simple abstract must contain a minimum of 1 (one) and a maximum of 2 (two) pages. The case report must contain a minimum of 2 (two) and a maximum of 8 (eight) pages. The presentation model must contain a minimum of 2 (two) and a maximum of 10 (ten) pages. The poster must contain a minimum of 1 (one) and a maximum of 4 (four) pages. All models must be submitted in Word format through the event's website form.

Art. 6º. Each work must have a maximum of 10 (ten) authors and cannot exceed 35 (thirty-five) pages.

§ 1º The article must be submitted in Word format with Times New Roman font, size 12,

following ABNT standards.

Art. 7°. There is no limit to the number of submissions per author.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Art. 8°. The evaluation committee mentioned in Art. 1°, §3° of this notice will evaluate all articles.

Art. 9°. The evaluation criteria for the articles will be:

- a) grammatical correctness;
- b) form appropriateness;
- c) appropriate language;
- d) research source strategy;
- e) reasoning and rhetoric;
- f) persuasiveness.

PRESENTATIONS

Art. 10°. Recorded - The video must be recorded in landscape format (i.e., if using a mobile phone for recording, the device should be laid horizontally). The total duration must be at least 7 (seven) minutes and no more than 10 (ten) minutes.

If using visual tools for the presentation, it is suggested to use PowerPoint to record the presentation, as it facilitates the viewing of the speaker and the slides simultaneously.

Once the recording is made, it must be submitted through the Seven website in the designated video submission section as a YouTube link AFTER PAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE.

Art. 11°. Live - The presentation will take place on the event day via the Google Meet platform, and the presenter must be online at the time of their presentation. To check the best available time, please wait for email instructions for schedule setup.

Art. 12° Publication only - In this mode, no presentation is required; simply submit the written work according to the congress model, and we will follow the same process as for other works.

FINAL PROVISIONS

Art. 13°. Participation in this event will not grant participants any other rights or advantages that are not explicitly stated in this regulation.

Art. 14°. Participants will receive certificates of participation (attendees) and/or article presentation. The congress proceedings will be published and will receive CrossRef/DOI registration and certification of oral scientific work presentation at the congress.

Art. 15°. Participants declare and tacitly agree that they are the authors or co-authors of the works, being responsible for them, and exempting Seven Publicações LTDA, its partners, and organizers from any civil, criminal, copyright, or other liabilities that may arise due to

irregularities caused by the participants.

Art. 16°. Participants agree with all the rules established in this regulation, and authorize the use of their name and image in any communication vehicle or tool for the purpose of event promotion.

Art. 17°. This event, as well as its regulation, may be altered, suspended, or canceled, with prior notice, due to force majeure or any other unforeseen factor beyond the control of Seven Publicações LTDA, compromising the regular conduct of the promotion, preventing or substantially altering the planned execution.

Art. 18°. Other issues not covered in this notice will be decided by the event's organizing committee. In addition, the decisions will be final, irrevocable, and non-appealable. Simple participation in this event implies full knowledge and unrestricted acceptance of this regulation.
