



# SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR THE REVISTA BRASILEIRA MEDICINA DE EXCELÊNCIA (RBME)

# **Title**

- Be concise and straight to the point.
- Use keywords that identify the main theme of the work.
- Avoid abbreviations and unfamiliar jargon.
- Be descriptive, but avoid being overly detailed.
- Use clear and precise language.
- Avoid asking questions or using question marks.
- Use the active voice instead of the passive voice.

# **Authors**

- All authors must include the following information:
  - Full name
  - Highest obtained qualification
  - Affiliation institution
  - ORCID or Lattes Identifier
  - Valid email address.
- Each article can contain up to 12 authors.

#### **Abstract**

- Should contain:
  - Problem contextualization: a brief description of the research problem addressed in the article.
  - Objectives: a clear statement of the research objectives.
  - Methods: a brief description of the methods used in the research.
  - Results: a brief description of the main results and findings of the research.
  - Conclusions: A clear exposition of the main conclusions and implications of the research.
- The abstract should have between 150 and 250 words and be written in the third person, without using citations or bibliographic references.





# **Keywords**

• Each text must include a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 keywords.

### Content

- All papers must include introduction, methodology, results, discussion, and conclusion.
- The article must contain a minimum of 15 pages and a maximum of 25 pages, including bibliographic references and notes.

# References

- References should be listed in alphabetical order by the author's last name or by the title of the work if there is no author.
- For book references, include the author's name, book title, edition, publisher, location, and publication date.
- Example:
  - Author's last name, First name. Book Title. Edition. Place of publication: Publisher, publication date.
